# REGULATION



## 1. ORGANIZERS AND PROMOTERS

The MARATEALE is a film festival organized by the Associazione Cinema Mediterraneo (<https://www.marateale.com>) and will take place in the amphitheater of the prestigious Santavenere Hotel.

## 2. MARATEALE IN SHORT – ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

The "MARATEALE IN SHORT" competition is open to all fiction short films, Italian and international, of any genre.

All submitted works must be recent productions, completed not before than January 1, 2023, and have a duration of less than 25 minutes, produced on any medium.

The selection of the ten finalist short films is made by the Jury and the Artistic Direction of the Festival, and their decisions are final and indisputable.

## 3. LOCATION – DATE

The MARATEALE IN SHORT competition will be part of the MARATEALE event, which will take place in Maratea (Pz) from July 23rd to 27th, 2024.

## 4. GIURIA

The Festival management will appoint a Jury composed of personalities from the world of Cinema and Art.

## 5. LEGITIMATE REPRESENTATIVE:

The person submitting the film assumes the responsibility of being the legitimate representative authorized by all rights holders of the work. The declaration made by the individual who has signed the registration form therefore exempts the Associazione Cinema Mediterraneo from verifying the legitimacy of the submission, which will be deemed established, thereby absolving it from any related responsibility.

## 6. REGISTRATION

Registration of films for the MARATEALE IN SHORT section can be done by downloading the form from the website <https://www.marateale.com> and sending it in Word format to the address: [maratealeinshort@gmail.com](mailto:maratealeinshort@gmail.com) no later than 10/6/2024. It is essential that the film submission via Vimeo link or any other digital means has a valid password until 31/07/2024. The deadline for sending registrations is 10/06/2024.

Alternatively, you can send a DVD, Blu-ray, or DCP to the address (the DVD must be received by 10/06/2024):

The method of sending the film must be indicated by selecting the chosen option on the preselection form. Films in preselection must be without subtitles if the original version is in Italian; with English or Italian subtitles if the original version of the film is in a different language.

## 7. SELECTED FILMS

Among the ten finalist short films, the winner of the Millennium Award competition will automatically enter. The official selection of films will be announced by 1/07/2024. Subsequently, promotional material for the films can be sent by 8/07/2024 via email: photographs, flyers, articles if available.

## 8. HOSPITALITY

The organization will offer accommodation for a maximum of two people for the presentation of selected films participating in the MARATEALE IN SHORT competition. Directors and lead actors will be given priority.

## 9. AWARDS

The artistic director and the jury will confer the following awards:

- MARATEALE IN SHORT AWARD
- RAI CINEMA CHANNEL AWARD

"The winner of the Marateale in Short award will have the opportunity to participate in the qualification program for the 2025 Oscars by Voce Spettacolo, through promotion at the Lumiere Cinema in Beverly Hills, provided that the short film meets all the requirements established by the regulations of the Academy of Motion Pictures Arts and Sciences for the 2025 Academy Awards."

"The Rai Cinema Channel award, worth € 2,000.00, consists of an exclusive web and free TV rights acquisition contract for the Italian territory, for the short film for 3 years by Rai Cinema, and will enjoy visibility on [www.raicinemachannel.it](http://www.raicinemachannel.it), its partner sites, and, at the discretion, on Rai channels. The materials to be delivered must be in MP4 format in HD and MXF."

## 10. GENERAL RULES

The submission of works implies full and unconditional acceptance of these regulations. The submission implies non-exclusive authorization to the festival organizers to broadcast and make available to the public - through their website and by any other means or form known - some sequences of the presented works (max 20 sec.), without claiming any compensation for the authors. The submission of photographic and/or informational material (scene photos, author photos, biography and filmography, film synopsis, author's statement, poster...) related to the film also implies non-exclusive authorization to the Festival organizers to distribute and make available to the public - through publication in the catalogue and on the official Festival website and by any other means or form known - images and information related to the works presented. The decisions regarding the awards are final. All films (in any format) will be insured against any damages with an "all risks" insurance policy (including loss or theft of the copy), arranged by the Festival for the entire period during which the copies will remain in its possession. In case of loss or damage to the copy, the Festival's liability is limited to the reprint value of the copy according to the rates in force in Italy. The Festival Management may make decisions regarding matters not covered by these regulations. The competent court for any disputes is the Court of Lagonegro.
